Course Description:

A monthly seminar series that brings eminent national and international chemosensory scientists from outside the university to UF's campus. The goal of the seminar series is to give participants a greater understanding of chemosensory mechanisms and to promote an appreciation, beyond the chemosensory community itself, of the need and impact of chemosensory research. Speakers are invited from all aspects of chemoreception, including basic, clinical, and applied research in the chemical senses (gustation, olfaction and trigeminal sensation), in both humans and in animals. Invited speakers will present one Wednesday each month for 1 hr. Students will then meet as a group with the speaker for a 1 hr discussion on his/her research and on other topics related to careers in science. Twice monthly (on alternate Wednesdays), registered students will participate a formal 1 hr discussion with UFCST faculty on the general concepts underlying the preceding presentation. Each enrolled student will lead one presentation during the semester, extra sessions will be led by the most relevant faculty member from the Center's membership. Open enrollment.
